The Regular Meeting of the Deerfield Village Council was called to order by President Todd Nighswander at 7:00 p.m.

Motion Eggleston to give Rodney a \$5.00/hr pay increase, retro active to Aug. 25, for new position as Superintendent. Second Rogers - Carried Offer accepted by Rodney Conner and he said the increase will include any additional licenses he obtains in the future.
