

**VILLAGE OF DEERFIELD
RESCHEDULED MEETING**

The Meeting of the Deerfield Village Council was called to order by President Todd Nighswander at 7:00 p.m. Trustees Present: Karla BocsKay, Donna Holubik, Kevin Eggleston, Dave Rogers & Mike Gilson Absent: Connie Sieler

Guests: Jay Maher Boy Scout Troop 646 from Sand Creek & Nora Maher

Minutes of the Regular meeting were read & approved

Treasurer's Report – Motion Eggleston to approve treasurer's report 2nd Rogers – Carried. New water/sewer bill collection policy has proven successful. Other than unoccupied properties and properties shut off - all accounts are paid in full.

Village Supt.'s Report – Brush pick-up will be Oct. 20TH & 21ST. Keegan St. generator is on line. Council requested hydrant on N. County Line be repaired.

Village President Report – A letter will be mailed to property owner of the storm sewer tie in to clarify information and council will determine action to be taken.

Bldg. Insp. Report & Police Report - reviewed

Planning Commission – Minutes were reviewed. No inquiries have been received regarding the open position.

Public Comment: Council discussed use of golf carts on Village streets. It was determined that any laws impacting the ability to ride a golf cart on local streets are enforced by law authority. Street conditions were discussed. Will request Superintendent Conner obtain information for short term and long term repairs.

New Business: Overtime for Aug. Reviewed. Council will review handbook to discuss at next council meeting. Trick or Treat will be Oct. 31st 6:00 – 7:30 pm. Jay Mahor Boy Scout from Troop 646 from Sand Creek requested approval from Council for his Eagle Project consisting of placing a bike rack in the park. He will conduct a letter campaign to raise funds for the project. Motion BocsKay to approve project and cover cost of cement for the project. To be supervised by Superintendent Conner. Second Gilson – Carried. Lighting of the Christmas Tree will be Dec. 6th. Motion: Nighswander to adopt a resolution recognizing Light of Christ Altar Rosary Society as a non-profit organization for the purpose of obtaining charitable gaming licenses. Second Holubik – Carried. Fibertech's request of a Metro Act permit will be reviewed.
