Minutes of the Regular meeting were read & approved.

Treasurer's Report –Sieler will contact TLC to compare banking rates but Village will remain with Old National at this time. Motion Sieler to approve treasurer's report. Second Rogers – Carried.

Motion Rogers to repair alley per estimate from Cadillac Asphalt, check with Day Construction and see if they will put the cost of the Consumers repairs into the project and to fill the cracks on E. Complainants were heard about speeding on Park St. Council recommends residents report license plate numbers to the police department for action.
