Amendment to Ordinance 6, Weed Control

Village of Deerfield, Lenawee County, Michigan

THE VILLAGE OF DEERFIELD HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Amendment to Section 1 of Ordinance 6

Section 3.a. of Ordinance 6, the Village of Deerfield Weed Control Ordinance is amended as follows:

Section 3. Work Done by Village

- a. If the provisions of the foregoing sections are not complied with, the Village Council may cause such weeds, grass or other vegetation to be cut, removed or destroyed and a minimum cutting fee, as may be established from time to time by resolution of the Village Council, to cover the costs associated with enforcement or the actual cost of cutting, whichever is greater shall be billed to the owner of the property. If payment in full is not received within 30 days from the due date, a late fee in the amount of \$50.00 shall be charged. If full payment is not received, the amount owed to the city shall be collected as a special assessment against the premises as provided by ordinance.

Section 2. Other Provisions to Remain in Effect.

All other provisions of Ordinance 6 shall remain in effect.

Section 3. Severability

If any court of law of equity within the State of Michigan determines that any provision within this Ordinance is unconstitutional, void, voidable, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of the same Section and other Sections of this Ordinance shall be deemed separate, distinct and valid in all respects from said provision.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its adoption.
